DISCUSSION WAS HELD ON WHERE WE WILL RUN THE SEWER LINES, AND WHAT AREA WE CONSIDERED LINES FROM THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMING GLEN, AND CERTAIN AREAS SURROUNDING SILVERDALE.

MR. SHOEMAKER SUGGESTED WE LOOK INTO RUNNING INTERCEPTOR LINES FROM THE BORDER OF HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP, THRU PERKASIE BOROUGH TO THEIR COLLECTOR LINE.
