THE SUPERVISORS OF HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP , MET AT THE TOWNSHIP BUILDING LOCATED ON ROUTE 113 & DIAMOND STREET, SILVERDALE, PA. WITH ALL SUPERVISORS PRESENT.

VISITORS PRESENT WERE MR. GUBELMAN, MR. WENTZ, MR. HEIDRICH, MR. MOORE , MR. KAPPEL, MR. BISHOP, MR. MAMINSKI, REPORTERS, MR. MITCHELL NORTH PENN, MR. CRESSMAN, CALL-CHRODDLE , GAIL ROHLAND, FREE PRESS, LORRAINE CAMPBELL, INTELLINGENCER .

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 9. O'CLOCK A.M. BY THE CHAIRMAN, WHO REQUESTED MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING BE READ. HELD ON January 8 1972 ON A MOTION BY MR. HARTSHORNE TO ACCEPT MINUTES AS READ. MOTION SECONDED BY MR. FRANKENFIELD.

A MOTION TO PAY ALL BILLS, BY MR. HARTSHORNE, MOTION SECONDED BY MR. FRANKENFIELD.

A RESOLUTION, RESCINDING THE APPOINTMENT OF WILLIAM LEIBIG, DEPUTY RECORDER DEEDS, AS REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX COLLECTOR, AND APPOINTING , THE BUCKS RECORDER OF DEEDS OFFICE AS OUR REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX COLLECTOR, FOR HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP. SO RESOLVED THIS TWENTY SECOND (22) DAY OF JANUARY 1972.

A LETTER OF APPRECIATION, FROM THE BUCKS COUNTY BANK & TRUST COMPANY, FOR DESIGNATING THEM THE DEPOSITORY FOR TOWNSHIP FUNDS, FOR THE YEAR 1972. ALL SUPERVISORS SIGNED THE APPLICATION , FOR A SAFE DEPOSIT BOX #257 N.

WE RECEIVED FROM ELIZABETH ^{MOYER} \$4,531.25 CTS , FOR REAL ESTATE TRANSFER CHECKS THAT WERE MAILED TO THE SUPERVISORS.

WE WERE NOTIFIED BY OUR SOLICITOR , IF THE SUPERVISORS WISHED TO EXEMPT , PERSONS WITH INCOMES OF ~~TWO~~ THOUSAND OR LESS FROM THE PER CAPITA, OCCUPATIONAL AND OCCUPANTIONAL PRIVILEGE TAX , UNDER THE LOCAL TAX ENABLING ACT. SECRETARY TO HAVE OUR SOLICITOR TO DRAW UP A RESOLUTION FOR OUR REVIEW.

MR. MOYER, WAS APPOINTED AS A VOTING DELEGATE, TO THE (50) ANNUAL CONVENTION OF THE PENNSYLVANIA SUPERVISORS ASSOCIATION. MR. HARTSHORNE AS AN ALTERNATE DELEGATE.

WE NOTIFIED THE BUCKS COUNTY BOARD OF ASSESSMENT OUR REAL ESTATE TAX FOR 1972 WA .005 MILLS.

MR. WENTZ, WANTED TO KNOW IF THE DRAINAGE , ON THE GROSS & QUADE PROPERTY WOULD BE TAKEN CARE OF PROPERLY. OUR ENGINEER WILL REVIEW THIS PROBLEM BEFORE APPROVAL.

MR. MAMINSKI, WANTED TO KNOW IF HIS PROPERTY , LOCATED ON ROUTE 309 AT UNIONVILLE , WOULD NEED TO BE REZONED AND IF THERE WOULD BE SEWERS IN THIS AREA. THERE WILL BE NO REZONING REQUIRED, NOR ARE SEWERS CONTEMPLATED IN THIS AREA.

MR. KAPPEL, A RESIDENT OF RICKERT ROAD, STATED THAT THE COSTS OF SEWER WERE HIGH. THEY ARE ESTIMATED COSTS. AT THIS TIME.

MR. GUBELMAN, STATED THAT IF 50 % OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS , DID NOT WANT SEWERS, WE COULD NOT PROCEED. THIS IS CORRECT, BUT THEY MUST INFORM THE SUPERVISORS OF THEIR WISHES.

MR. MOHR, STATED THAT HE THOUGHT THE SECRETARY SHOULD PHONE EACH RESIDENT AND ASK THEIR WISHES. WE SUPERVISORS HAVE MEETING TWICE A MONTH AND THE MEETINGS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, WE HAVE BEEN ASKED BY THE BUCKS COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES , TO CORRECT AREAS, WHERE THEY HAVE MALFUNCTIONING ON SITE SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM. SUPERVISORS ARE GOING TO ADVERTISE FOR A 3/4 TON PICKUP TRUCK, A NEW POLICE CAR, STONE, OIL , GASOLINE AND BITUMINIOUS MATERIALS, BIDS TO BE OPENED FEBRUARY 19, 1972. AT 10.0'CLOCK A.M.

READ A LETTER WILLIAM F. COYLE OF THE FIRM OF ABRAHAM & LOWENSTEIN , TO MR. JACZUN WHO REPRESENT THE TOWNSHIP. IN THE CASE OF MAGER - INDUSTRIAL BOARD THAT THE INDUSTRIAL BOARD REAFFIRMED THEIR DECISION , TO GRANT A VARIANCE TO MR. MAGER.

IF THE TOWNSHIP , WISHES TO APPEAL THE DECISION OF THE BOARD OF THE COMMONWEALTH COURT, THE APPEAL MUST BE FILED NO LATER THAN JANUARY 24, 1972. THE COST FOR FILING THE APPEAL WOULD BE \$1,256.00 INCLUDING 25 HOURS,, ANY HOURS IN EXCESS OF THE 25 HOURS WOULD COST \$40.00 PER HOUR.

MR. JACZUN ADVISE WE DO NOT FILE THE APPEAL.

MR. GUBELMAN STATED THAT THEY WERE VIOLATING THERE OWN LAW, MR. HARTSHORNE SUGGESTED , THAT WE HAVE OUR ATTORNEY WRITE THEM A LETTER, THAT THE TOWNSHIP WAS NOT PLEASED WITH THEIR DECISION. SECRETARY INFORMED THE SOLICITOR AND WE WILL RECEIVE A COPY OF THE LETTER.

MR HARTSHORN IS GOING TO HOLD A FIRESIDE CHAT WITH RESIDENTS FEBUARY I, 1972 RECEIVED FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, COMMONWEALTH PF PENNSYLVANIA AUDIT REPORT OF THE LIQUID FUELS TAX FUND FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY I, 1970 TO DECEMBER 31, 1970. WHICH FOUND TO CORRECT.
