Milltona desires that the Bucks County Historical Commission

act as the Tourist Promotion Agency for the County of Bucks,

Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolved.

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors of the Tourship

of HILLTOWN concurs in the Resolution dated August 8, 1961, 21

the Board of Commissioners of the County of Bucks and hereby approves the designation of the Bucks County Historical Commission as the Tourist Promotion Agency to represent the County of Bucks in all matters relevant to and for all purposes of the Tourist Promotion Law.
