RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF Af $11+\mathrm{m} k$ CONCURRING IN THE RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF BUCKS, PENTSYLVANIA, DESIGNATING THE BUCKS COUNTY HISTORICAL COMMISSION AS THE TOURIST PROMOTION AGENCY FOR THE COUNTY OF BUCKS IN ALL MATTERS RELEVANT TO AND FOR ALL PTJRPOSES OF THE TOURIST PROMOTION LAW.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of All/tond desires that the Bucks County Historical Commission act as the Tourist Promotion Agency for the County of Bucks, Pennsylvania.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and it is hereby resolve-:
Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors of the Turinsht HILLTOUN concurs in the Resolution dated August 8, 1961. 21
the Board of Commissioners of the County of Bucks and hereby approves the designation of the Bucks County Historical Commission as the Tourist Promotion Agency to represent the County of Bucks in all matters relevant to and for all purposes of the Tourist Promotion Law
