MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY THE CHAIRMAN, MR. HOCKMAN, WITH ALL SUPERVISORS PRESENT.

MEETING OPENED WITH THE SECRETARY READING THE MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 6, 1971. MOTION BY MR. FRANKENFIELD TO ACCEPT MINUTES AS READ. MOTION SECONDED BY MR HOCKMAN.

KELLER, MR STRITZINGER, MR. CROUTHAMEL, MR. HEIDRICH, MR. BROWNING, MR. BAUM, MRS BRETT,

MR KEELER ASKED THE SUPERVISORS , IF THE SUPERVISORS WOULD PAY THE COSTS OF JANITOR SERVICE FOR RECREATION PURPOSES AT THE JOHN GRASSE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND THE SEYLAR SCHOOL. SUPERVISORS AGREED TO APPROPRIATE AN AMOUNT THE BUDGET FOR 1972.
