MR. FRENCH READ A LETTER TO THE SUPERVISORS, THAT WE DO NOT CONTINUE OUR SUIT

AGAINST MR. HORN , THE QUARRY OWNER IF THE QUARRY WOULD BE CLOSED THEY WOULD HAVE NO EMPLOYMENT.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SDATED THAT THERE SUIT IS AGINST MR. HORN , WAS THAT HE DID NOT APPLY FOR A VARIANCE OR PERMIT WHICH IS AGINST THE ZONING DRDINANCE , MR . HORN HAS SEEN ORDERD BY JUDGE LUDWID TO APPLY FOR A VARIANCE HEARING, SEFOR THE ZONING HEAR-ING BOARD , AND IF THIS SHOULD NOR GRANTED .
