BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HILLTOWN, COUNTY OF BUCKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY AUTHORITY OF THE SAME AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 601- OF THE HILLTOWN TOWNSHIP SUBDIVISION REGULATION ADOPTED DECEMBER 2, 1987, IS HEREBY AMENDED BY ADDING SECTION 601-1 WHICH READS AS FOLLOWS.

SECTION GOI-I IN THE EVENT THAT A PROPOSED RESIDENTIAL SUBDIVISION RESULTS IN THE CREATION OF NO MORE THAN THREE LOT'SINCLUDING THE ORIGINAL LOT, TRACT PARCELLAND, THEN AND IN THAT EVENT, THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS MAY MODIFY OR AFJUST THE IMPROVEMENTS AND STANDARDS REQUIRED UNDER THIS ORDINANCE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO STREET IMPROVEMENTS, CURBING, AND SUCH OTHER MODIFICATIONS AS ARE REQUIRED TO PERMIT REASONABLE UTILIZATIONOF THE PROPERTY WHILE STILL PERMITTING AND SECURING SUBSTANTIAL CONFORMANCE, WITH THE OBJECTIVES OF THE REGULATIONS.

SO ENACTED AND ORDAINED THIS 7TH DAY OF AUGUST, A.D. 1971.
