PRESENT WERE MR. FRANKENFIELD, MR. MOYER. MR FRANKENFIELD ACTED AS CHAIRMAN IN THE ABSENCE OF MR. HOCKMAN.

SUPERVISORS SIGNED LINEN COPY FOR THE INGVAL MELBY TRACT, LOCATED ON STUMP ROAD MARCH 27, 1971. THIS PLAN WAS ORIGINALY SIGNED THE 18TH DAY OF FEBUARY 1967. AND RECORDED, BUT ~~PLAN~~ WAS LOST , OR RECORDED UNDER SOME ONE ELSE NAME.

RECEIVED FROM GLENN M. MOYER REAL ESTATE TRANSFER TAX COLLECTOR THE AMOUNT OF \$2,530.24⁰.

POLICE PENSION AUDIT WAS RECEIVED BY THE SUPERVISORS, WITH THE ACCOUNT IN ORDER.

MR. HEATH MR. BROWNING, MR. GILMORE ⁴QUESTINED THE REQUIREMENT OF CURBING ALONG DEVELOPMENTS AT THIS TIME.

SUPERVISORS STATED THAT WITH INCREASED DRAINAGE PROBLEMS, AND WITH THE APPROVAL OF OUR ENGINEER, THAT THIS WOULD BE A REQUIREMENT IN ALL DEVELOPMENTS OF MORE THAN 2 LOTS.

MR. KELLER , ASKED IF THIS WOULD BE REQUIRED OF ALL HOME OWNERS, HE WAS INFORMED THAT THIS REQUIREMENT WAS ONLY ON NEW DEVELOPMENTS AT THIS TIME.

CITIZENS PRESENT VOICED THEIR APPROVAL, THAT THE SUPERVISORS REQUIRED CURBS AND PAVING ALONG NEW DEVELOPMENTS.

OUR ENGINEER, RICHARD COWAN ASSOCIATES, RECOMENDS THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION, SUPERVISORS AND ENGINEER, NOT SIGN ANY PLANS WITHOUT THE OWNER ~~XXX~~ SIGNING THEM FIRST WITH HIS NAME AND ADDRESS.

MRS ROSE GEORGE REQUESTED , THE SUPERVISORS TO PETITION THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, TO HAVE THE SPEED LIMIT REDUCED TO 45 MILES PER HOUR ON HILLTOWN PIKE. (919)

SECRETARY TO TAKE PLANS OF THE CONLIN TRACT, LOCATED ON BROAD STREET TO OUR SOLICITOR TO HAVE AN AGREEMENT, STATING ~~XMAX~~ ON THE PLAN, THAT EACH LOT OWNER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF THIS PRIVATE ROAD.
