The Regular Semi-Monthly Meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was held this day, with all members present - Mr. Frankenfeld, Presiding. The minutes of the previous meeting were read & approved. Bills amounting to \$ 7,937.14 from the Township funds were read, approved and ordered paid. A letter from Mrs. Kathryn Parsons was read, said letter being a request for the Board to erect or start proceedings for the erection of a signal light on Rt 309 + Hilltown Pike. The Board discussed this problem & decided that this requires, Hatfield and New Britain Townships to share in this expenditure. Mr. Agin, was instructed to proceed scheduling a meeting with the two Township Boards. The Amusement Tax Ordinance, which had been advertised per the second class Township Code, was read - and opened for discussion, there being none, a motion by Mr. Frankenfeld, seconded by Mr. Hickman to adopt said ordinance was made, ^{voting was} ~~unanimous~~ unanimous. Mr. Cooney, was present to pay his 1963 trailer park license. Mr. Lee, was present representing the School Board and a problem that exists in the construction of the "John Geisse School" the problem being curb lines & paving of the ditch from existing road to proposed curb. The Board explained they would pave all of road within the right-of-way of the Board's existing road, this leaves a strip about 18 inches wide to be paved by the School Board. The Board suggested, they would be willing to pave the school board's share when doing their own & Bill school board for same. The feeling was that the supervisors ^{could} ~~can~~ construct this piece of road cheaper, than the contractor for the school road. Mr. Lee, ~~is~~ in agreement, asked if Mr. Agin, would write the school board a letter of intent, which Mr. Agin agreed to do. It was suggested, that because of conflicting dates, the meeting scheduled for ~~the~~ SAT - 6th of Oct be changed to Monday Evening Oct 8 - 1962, there being no question, meeting will be advertised for Monday Oct 8 - 1962 - 7:00 P.M. There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 1:30 P.M.
