The financial report was presented, ~~and~~ ^{and} approved. Bills amounting to \$1167.38 from the General Fund and \$1,008.13 from the State Funds were approved and ordered paid. The correspondence was read and the secretary was instructed to answer the letter from Dr. Lee, Doylestown, Pa and explain that no change had been discussed for the property joining him. A letter from the Bucks County Planning Comm was also read and the Board authorized a donation of \$100.00 to this very worthy organization. The Civil Defense director, Mr. Soliday, forwarded a list of Emergency Police qualified under Civil the defense ~~for that~~ ^{training} program for future use if needed. He also suggested the Board purchase some means of identification for these men. The Board suggested Mr. Frankfield bring in some literature at the next meeting. Mr. Fairwell, was present to show samples of screen doors & storm & screen for the Twp office. After viewing these samples an order was placed for 1 door \$42.20 & 3 windows @ 24.00 ea.
