Bills amounting to \$343.66 from the general fund, and \$856.70 from the State funds were approved & ordered paid. A letter from the Silverdale fire Co. was read and a donation of \$100.00 was approved. A lengthy discussion was held per the construction program for 1962. This discussion was on the type of finished product to be used on the proposed construction this year. The results were to meet with Mr. Morgan, of "Loper & Sharp Co.", to get an approximate cost of a machine finish on these roads. Results to be given at the next meeting. Mr. Agin, suggested the board look into the purchasing of a duplicating machine. The machine would be used to make the various forms that the township now is paying a premium for SMO forms. Mr. Agin, was instructed to bring in prices at the next meeting. The board also felt the need for window screens, and a screen door for the Twp. office. Mr. Frankfield is to report on this at the next meeting. There being no further business meeting adjourned at 1:15 to meet on May 26, 1962 to adopt the ordinance on Real Estate Transfer Tax.
