The semi-monthly meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by the Chairman, Mr. Frankenfield. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved. The Treasurer presented his report as shown on following page. Bills amounting \$878.61 from the general fund, and \$593.18 from the State funds were approved & ordered paid. A Permit was issued to Mr. Everett Garrett for the use of powercranes in his fruit orchard. The Board instructed the Secretary to order steel from Frank Weaver & Co, Lansdale, Pa for the bridge on "Eckert's Road". Upon a recommendation of our Civil Defense Director, Mr. Holiday, Mr. Frankenfield was appointed, "The Shelter Officer" for Hilltown Township fallout shelter. The Board was honored with the presence of Mr. Clay Hopkins, a freshman from Pennridge High School. Mr. Hopkins explained his class was studying government, both State & local and was here to obtain information. The Board answered his questions & also explained briefly the workings of Hilltown Township's elected & appointed officials. A discussion was had on the specs of the proposed new truck & snow plow, with no result at this time. The County Aid papers were prepared & signed for the proposed bridge.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned at 1:15 P.M. to meet at the Twp office on May 5-1962 at 9:00 A.M.
