

The regular semi-monthly meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by the chairman Mr. FRANKENFELD. The minutes of the previous meeting were read & approved. At the last meeting a suggestion by a member of the Board to curb the form of advertising used heretofore for Stone & Oil Bids was again discussed with the Secretary explaining the forms sent to him by the Highway Dept & their purposes. Mr. FRANKENFELD instructed the Secy to continue using the forms from the State, explaining the cost wouldn't be that much more. Upon discussing the construction program for 1962 with the Roadmaster, a bridge problem arose, said problem being on "ECKARTS ROAD", which is to be built this spring is a wooden bridge too narrow for the proposed traffic upon road completion. The Board felt it could not afford to demolish & erect a new bridge so instructed the Secy to contact Mr. Cowen, the Township Engineer to meet with them at the bridge site for professional advice. A Resolution adopting ~~the~~ & approving the sub-division plan of 11 lots for Mr. Robert Hewitt was presented. Motion by Mr. Heckman seconded by Mr. Agin - motion then carried. Bills amounting to \$905.75 was approved & ordered paid. There being no further business meeting adjourned to meet at the Township office - March 3 - 1962 - at 9:00 A.M.
