Those Attending were - Supervisors - Agin, Heckman, Frankenfield. - Mrs. Tyson, Mrs. Koljowski, Mr. & Mrs. Schell, Mrs. Finckelstein, Mrs. Deastine, Mrs. Gutman, Mrs. Feinka, - Taxpayers interested with the proceedings Regularizing handfills, - Mr. Moore, Mr. Kratz, Mr. Barney - Junk yard operators. - Mr. Roman - Taxpayer - with Complaint Against Neighbors - Mr. Deastine - Constable, Mr. Wilson - ~~Constable~~ ^{Chawyer}, Mr. Peters - Timing office. Mr. Rosenberger - Tax Collector, Chief of Police - Tyson.

The Minutes of the Previous Meeting were read - Approved. Mr. Moore - as Spokesman for the Junk yard operators - objected to the Police stopping burning in the Junk yards.
