Minutes of the previous meeting were read which
MR FINKELSTEIN protested, stating the minutes of Sept 5-1964

MR FINKELSTEIN QUESTIONED THE DUMPING OF GARBAGE
UNDER THE 1955 LAW. MR FINKELSTEIN, PRESENTED COPIES OF 3 ORDINANCES
(#5, #8, #9) of HAYCOCK TOWNSHIP TO THE BOARD, WHICH WERE FORWARDED TO
MR. WILSON, FOR STUDY. MR FINKELSTEIN ALSO CITED LACK OF ENFORCEMENT
UNDER SEC 1110, (NON CONFORMING USES) OF THE TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE.
UPON HEARING EVIDENCE OF NEGLECT FROM MR FINKELSTEIN AND GROUP,
MR. WILSON STATED HE WAS REVIEWING THE MATTER PRIOR TO DRAFTING
AN ORDINANCE.

MR. ROBT ALDERFER, presented preliminary Plans of the
"Melvin Meyer" sub-division, containing 40 homes. IT WAS SUGGESTED
THE BUCKS COUNTY PLANNING, THE HILLTOWN PLANNING COMMISSION AND HIS
