The Semi-Monthly Meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was held this day - Mr. Heckman, Presiding.

Those attending were Supervisors - Agin, Heckman, Frankenfield, Messer's Peters, Spandinger, Tyson - Detweiler. - Mayor Reese - Silverdale,

the minutes of the previous meeting were read & approved.

Bills amounting to \$3289.00 were read - approved for payment.

Motion by Agin - seconded Frankenfield, appointing Messrs. EDW. Broderick & Dave Gorman to the Industrial Development Committee carried - unanimously

Motion by Agin - seconded Heckman - appointing Mr. James Smith as Tax Co-ordinator for 1 year - motion - carried.

Motion by Agin - seconded Heckman - Re-Enacting the 1962 Ordinance imposing a Real Estate Transfer Tax - Carried - Unanimously.

Motion by Heckman - seconded Frankenfield - Re-Enacting the 1954 Ordinance imposing a Per Capita Tax on Residents of Hilltown Twp - Unanimously Carried.

Mr. William Detweiler - Requested action or ruling on zoning ordinance - against Mr. <sup>Smith</sup> ~~Morton~~ and his trailer, AND also his Septic system - Mr. Agin to contact Mr. Montemay for decision.

Mayor Reese, requested a portion of the Foreign Fire Ins. fund, for the Silverdale Fire Co. The Board explained they could only expend this money to the Fire Co located in the Township.

Mr. Peters, presented his zoning officer's report, showing progress.

A discussion by the possibility of adding a second floor in the garage for storage brought many ideas on how this should be finished, with no decision - project was turned over to the chairman to contact a reputable builder for survey & approximate price.

There being no further business, meeting adjourned - 2:15 P.M.
