The Semi-Monthly Meeting of the Hillman Township Board of Supervisors was held this day - Mr. Frankenkfield, Presiding.

The Minutes of the Previous Meeting were read - approved.

Bills amounting to \$3,482.56 from the General fund were read - Motion - Hickman - Seconded - Frankenkfield - Motion Carried to pay said bills.

Those present at this meeting were - Supervisors - Agin, Hickman, Frankenkfield. - Taxpayer Mr. Vernon Horn. - Zoning officer Peters - Police officer - DESTINE, Tax Collector - Rosenberger & Taxpayer Mr. Raymond Hess.

Under Old Business, the subject of Building "Skunk Hollow Road", was discussed. Mr. Agin, Reported Mr. Moutenay, the Township Solicitor advised, that there being no big variance of signers on the petition presented to the Board, the Board should follow their original plans. Motion - Agin - Seconded Hickman - that "Skunk Hollow Road", be built as originally planned for 1964. - Motion Carried.

A Resolution was passed - approving lot #4 of the Planned Industrial site, which has been sold. This making Plant #2 in the new site.

Mr. Rosenbergers - Report - showed approximately 92% of 1963 Taxes Collected to date.

A Discussion was held with Officer DESTINE, after his receipt of the letter written by the Solicitor, notifying him that the Board was re-organizing the Police Dept. under a full time program, & he would not be appointed for 1964; therefore the 30 day notice, under his equipment contract was forwarded so the Board could remove Township Property for future issue.

Mr. Agin - Requested permission to purchase office supplies. Motion Hickman - Seconded Frankenkfield - Permission Granted.

Whereas - the Township has been the victim of thieves, stealing gas from the gas tank, Motion - Agin - Seconded Hickman - ~~Motion Carried~~ instructing Mr. Agin - to get prices on a 1000 gal. underground tank with an electric pump. - Motion Carried.
