The Meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by the Chairman - Mr. Frankfield.

Minutes of the Previous Meeting were read - approved.

Bills amounting to \$1618.33 from the general fund were read and approved for payment.

A group of property owners on Diamond Street were present - protesting the erection of a mobile home on a small lot. Mr. Detweiler - the supervisor for the group, insisted the septic system, which was being erected, was to close to the natural stream. After a very lengthy discussion, Mr. Peters, the zoning officer was instructed to check this problem before it became permanent. This same group requested the Board to control the speeding along Diamond St from Sellersville Borough to Route 113. A Resolution was adopted requesting the Dept of Highways to conduct a traffic survey along this road to enable the Board to erect and control the speeding.

Motion by Heckman, seconded - Frankfield - Resolution for a traffic survey thru the village of Blooming Glen was unanimously approved.

Motion by Agin, seconded Heckman - Resolution for a traffic survey along Hilltown Pike (L.R. 919) from Bengels Road to the village of Hilltown, was unanimously approved.

Mr. Kuhn - Representative for the Quiet Acres Trailer Park made his application for 1964 licenses - 500 - issued said license.

Mr. Walsh, Mr. Egan - presented sub-division plans for 16 lots on 13.168 acres. This sub-division to be sold with the insertion on the single deeds that the road thru the sub-division was a private road and not a. therefore the township has no liability for this sub-division private road. Plans signed with this attached to plans.

There being no further business - meeting adjourned at 3:30 P.M. to meet Nov 2 - 1963 at the township office.
