The Semi-Monthly Meeting of the Hilltown Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by the Chairman - Mr. Frankenfild.

Those attending were Supervisors Agin, Heckman, & Frankenfild.

The Minutes of the Previous Meeting were read - approved.

Bills amounting to \$1111.48 from the General fund were read - approved for payment.

The Secy read a letter from the Hilltown Township Civic Ass. requesting the Board petition the Pa. Dept. of Highways for a traffic survey on Hilltown Pike for the proposal of a 35 mile per hr. speed zone. The Secy was instructed to contact the Dept. of Highways requesting this survey.

There being no old business - Mr. Frankenfild opened for New Business. Under New Business - Mr. Michaels - owning a non-conforming lot requested an extension on this lot which was lot #11 of the Fretz Penndridge #1 - sub-division. Motion by Agin - seconded Heckman motion carried.

Mrs. Brenner - complained about the Hill Quarry - water problem - sewerage - dust - dumping of sewerage on his fields - noise. After much discussion the Chairman advised her the Board would contact the Air-Pollution Board - in Phila. for an inspection at their earliest date.

The Representative from the "Audio Center CB-Radio's", explained the uses - construction - advantages - of the Poly-Comm-Radio, which the Board is contemplating purchasing for the trucks - "Audio Center - to forward prices for 3-truck set - 1-base set Equip. with aerials & installed.

Mr. Knaefer - requested an extension on his non-conforming lot - request - granted - notified zoning officer - Peters.

Mr. Nungesser - upon a request of the Board - ~~to~~ <sup>brought</sup> forth prices for garage tools. Tools to cost \$638.59 - motion - Agin - seconded Heckman - motion carried to purchase same.
