



When to dispose of an American Flag and where can I do this?

The U.S. Flag Code says. “The flag, when it is in such condition that it is no longer a fitting emblem for display, should be destroyed in a dignified way, preferably by burning”. When an American flag is worn beyond repair, it should be retired in a respectful manner.

Boy Scout Troop 67 of Hilltown, PA holds an annual flag burning ceremony to pay respect and properly retire American flags.

Boy Scout, Andrew Williams has built a U.S. flag retirement box that will be housed in the lobby of Hilltown Township building, as his eagle scout project. Hilltown Township building address is: 13 West Creamery Road Hilltown, PA 18927.

U.S. flags can be dropped off at this box, and Boy Scout Troop 67 will collect them and make sure they are properly retired.
